Consequent upon having been elected Mr. Aryan Saini as student representative in Grievance Redressal Committee in the election held on 16/02/2024, and in pursuance of the All India Council for Technical Education (Redressal of Grievance of Students) Regulations, 2019, a "STUDENTS' GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE" (SGRC) is reconstituted in this Institute with immediate effect for addressing & effectively resolving the grievances of students, with the following composition:

- a) The term of the members and the special invitee shall be of two years.
- b) The quorum for the meeting including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee shall be three.
- c) In considering the grievances before it, the SGRC shall follow the principles of natural justice.
- d) Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Student Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the Ombudsperson of GGSIP University within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision.

GRIEVANCES MAY INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING COMPLAINTS OF THE AGGRIEVED STUDENTS DEALT WITH BY STUDENTS' GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE AS PER AICTE REGULATIONS 2012 NAMELY:

1. Making admission contrary to merit determined in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute:
2. Irregularity in the admission process adopted by the institute
3. Refusing admission in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute.
4. Withhold or refuse to return any document in the form of certificates of degree, diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or programme of study which such person does not intend to pursue.
5. Demand of money in excess of that specified in the declared admission policy or approved by the competent authority to be charged by such institution.
6. Breach of the policy for reservation in admission as may be applicable.
7. Complaints of alleged discrimination by students from Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes ,OBC, women, minority or disabled categories.
8. No payment or delay in payment of Scholarships to any students that such institution is committed, under the conditions imposed by AICTE, or by any other authority.
9. Delay in conduct of examinations or declaration of results beyond that specified in the academic calendar.
10. On provision of student amenities as may have been promised or required to be provided by the institution.
11. Denial of quality education as promised at the time of admission or required to be provided.
12. Non transparent or unfair evaluation practices.
13. Harassment and Victimization of students including sexual harassment.
14. Refund of fees on withdrawal of admissions as per AICTE instructions from time to time.


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
