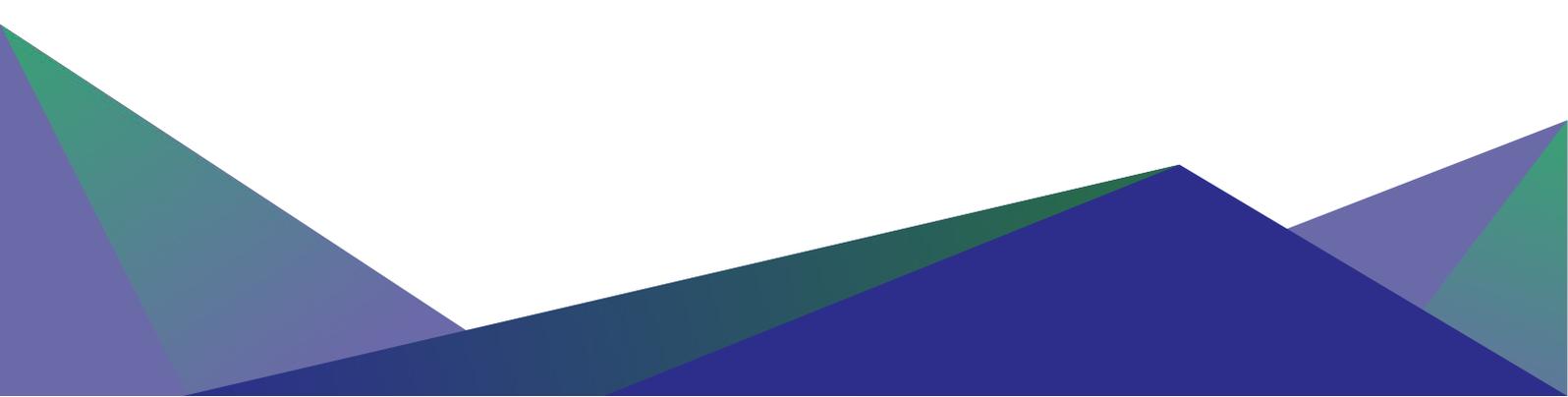

Authors should adhere to the following:

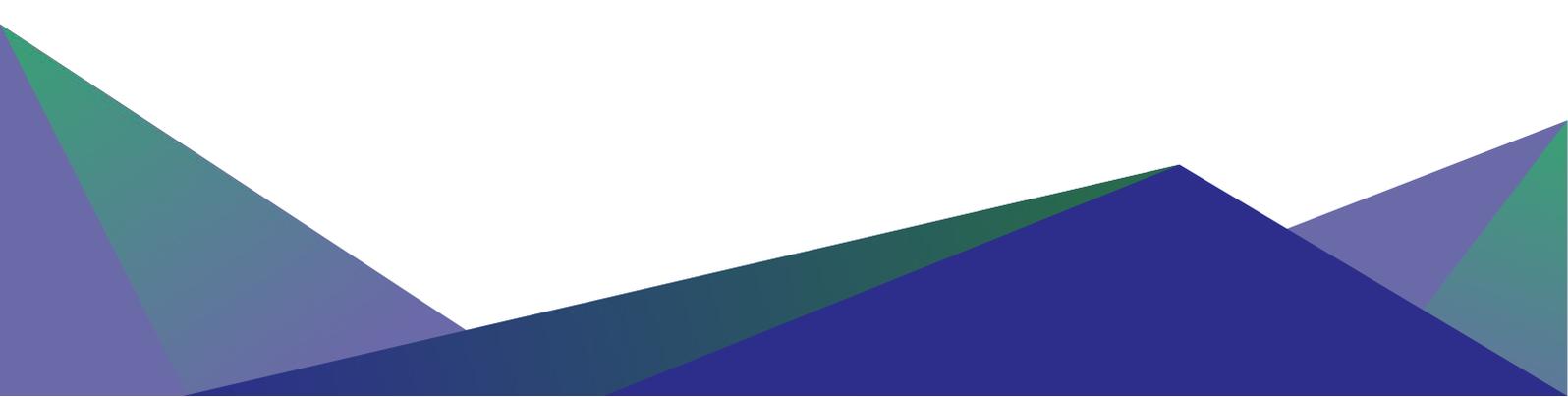

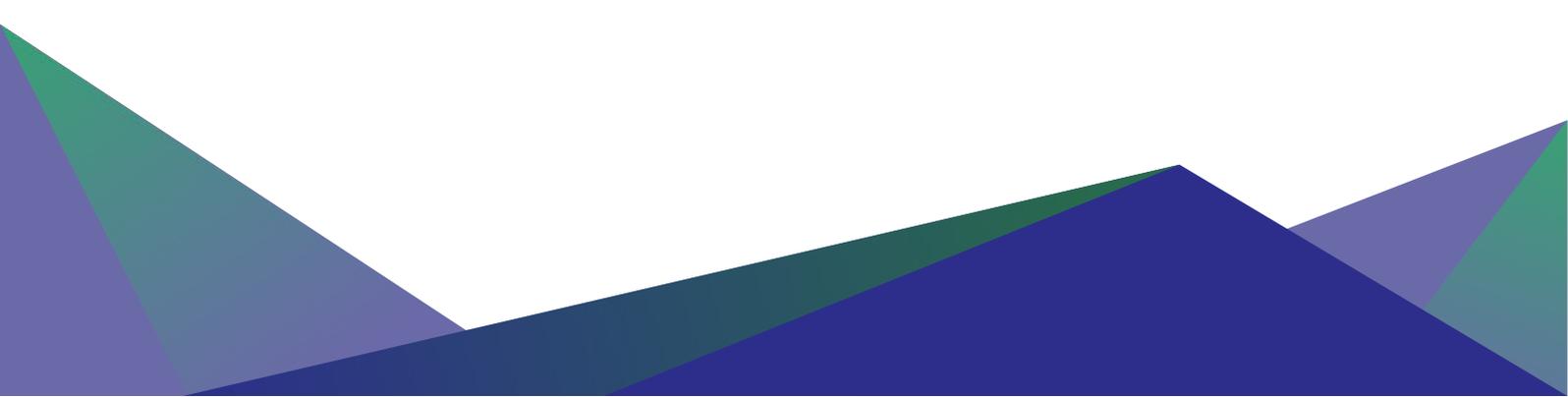
REVIEW PROCESS
