Alumni Feedback Analysis and ATR

The alumni committee of the college collects alumni feedback on syllabus and the facilities provided by the college annually. A specified sample is taken for the analysis. A well designed and structured questionnaire has been used to collect the responses. The alumni were given an opportunity to rate the syllabus and the facilities provided by the college on a four-scale measurement. The objective of the feedback is to analyze the importance and relevance of the course and curriculum, the functional nature of the course, the co-curricular activities in the college, and the influence of campus environment of the college in their life. It also tries to evaluate the contribution of the college in their overall personality development, the career orientation of the syllabus, and also the infrastructure and facilities provided by the college. Feedback form was given to Alumni on 11 questions to obtain their input as feedback is essential for successful planning. Alumni feedback was taken in the offline format during the alumni reunion. The main objective of this feedback is to involve the alumni in the developmental process of the institution.

The response of the alumni to all the parameters ranged between good and excellent. Most of the alumni felt proud to be a part of the college and thankful to the college for providing quality education and appreciate the dedicated faculty. They felt that the College played a crucial role in shaping their personal and professional life. The college has stuck to its vision of providing quality education to the less privileged section of society.

Strength

Minutes of Meeting

Subject : Faculty Feedback Analysis
Date : 20.01.2025

A meeting was convened on 20th January 2025 at 11:00 a.m. in the Principal's Office to analyse students' feedback on faculty performance and to recommend appropriate corrective measures and rewards based on the feedback received.

Members Present:

1. **Prof. Payal Pahwa**, Principal
2. **Dr. Achal Kaushik**, Dean Academics
3. **Prof. Abhijit Nayak**, Dean Administration

Agenda:

To review and analyze the consolidated student feedback report for all faculty members and to decide on necessary actions for improvement and recognition.

Discussion:

The Committee examined in detail the **consolidated feedback** submitted by the students, based on a score out of 100 for the following criteria:

1. Teacher's preparedness for the subject
2. Ability to explain (audibility and communication skills)
3. Clarity of writing on the board
4. Use of sufficient examples and problem-solving
5. Responsiveness to students' questions and doubts
6. Sufficiency and timeliness of assignments (checking, return, and discussion)
7. Rate of syllabus coverage (uniformity and completion)
8. Classroom management and discipline
9. Availability of faculty to students beyond class hours
10. General perception about the teacher

Recommendations:

a) Corrective Measures:

- An **advisory** shall be issued to all faculty members who scored **below 60%** in the student feedback.
- They are advised to make necessary improvements in their pedagogy, particularly in the areas where low scores were received.

b) Guidance Sessions:

- An **interactive session** shall be organized under the supervision of the respective **Heads of Departments (HODs)** to provide guidance and support to the concerned faculty members for improvement.

c) Recognition and Rewards:

- Faculty members who scored **above 80%** in the student feedback shall be given **due consideration** for the *Teacher's Excellence Award*, along with other parameters such as academic results, research contributions, and overall performance.

d) Continuous Improvement:

- Faculty members are encouraged to conduct **frequent open interactive sessions** with their students to self-evaluate and enhance their teaching methodologies.

Conclusion:

The meeting concluded with a **vote of thanks** to the Chair.
