GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished research papers, case studies, and practice-oriented contributions aligned with the conference theme "Growth, Adaptation and Reinvention – Empirical Evidence, Strategic Frameworks, and Applied Insights."

1. Types of Submissions

The conference welcomes the following categories of submissions:

- Empirical Research Papers
- Conceptual or Theoretical Papers
- Case Studies and Applied Research
- Industry and Practitioner Papers
- Policy and Institutional Analysis Papers

Submissions must not be under review or published elsewhere.

2. Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Abstract length: 250–300 words
- Clearly state the purpose, methodology, key findings, and implications
- Include 3–5 keywords

3. Full Paper Submission Guidelines

- Paper length: 3,000–5,000 words (excluding references)
- Format: Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)
- Page layout: A4 size, 1-inch margins
- Font: Times New Roman, 12-point
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Page numbers: Bottom center

4. Referencing Style

- Use APA (7th Edition) referencing style
- Ensure consistency and accuracy in citations and references
- Authors are responsible for plagiarism-free content

5. Review Process

- All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review
- Author-identifying information should appear only on the cover page
- Review decisions will be based on originality, relevance, rigor, and contribution

6. Acceptance and Presentation

- At least one author of each accepted paper must register and present at the conference

7. Publication Opportunities

- Accepted and presented papers will be included in the conference proceedings
- Selected high-quality papers may be considered for publication in partner journals or edited volumes (subject to additional review)

8. Ethical Standards

- Submissions must adhere to academic integrity and ethical research standards
- Any conflicts of interest or funding sources should be disclosed
- Plagiarism beyond acceptable limits will result in rejection

REVIEW PROCESS

All papers will be evaluated through a double-blind review process by experts from Institutions/ Universities/ Organizations of repute in and outside India. Only original, unpublished work is sought. Any proposal submitted to present identical or substantially similar work already published, under review for another conference or publication will not be considered. In the covering letter accompanying the manuscript, the contributors should certify that the manuscript has neither been published anywhere nor is it at present being considered anywhere for publication.

Participation certificate will be given to each participant.

All the paper presenters would receive a "Certificate of Presentation" and winners would receive "Certificate of Appreciation" also. Top three best papers would be awarded with attractive cash prizes.
